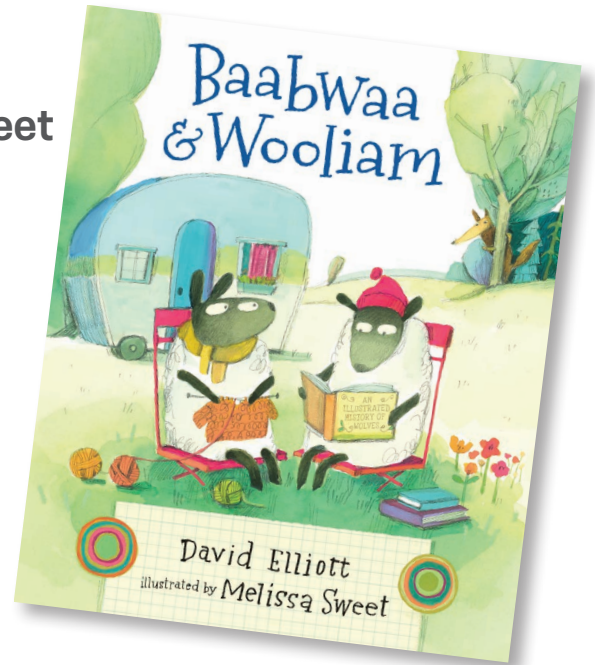


10 WAYS TO EXPLORE THIS BOOK

- 7 **SING** *Baa Baa Black Sheep* together
- 8 **DRAW** a picture of yourself doing something you love
- 9 **IMITATE** a “mournful lupine howl” and other lupine sounds
- 10 **SEARCH** for animals, plants, and insects outside your house

FIVE WAYS TO DISCOVER ANY BOOK WITH A CHILD

1

Talk about what the book makes you both think or feel.

2

Sing a song that is related to a character or something in the book.

3

Act out parts of the story.

4

Draw a picture of something that happened in the book.

5

Retell the story using the illustrations.
