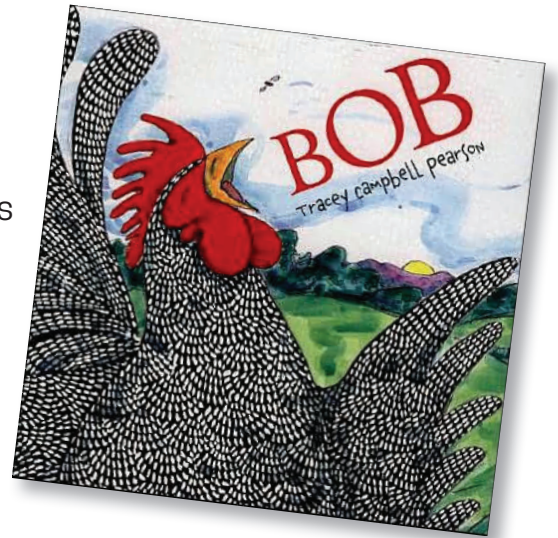


10 WAYS TO EXPLORE THIS BOOK

- 1 **BUILD** a “chicken coop” fort with blankets and pillows
- 2 **COUNT** the bugs you find on every page
- 3 **CREATE** a new way to say good morning
- 4 **LEARN** more about eggs, hens, and roosters
- 5 **DRAW** a picture of a farm
- 6 **IMAGINE** what other sounds Bob could learn from animals
- 7 **TALK** about people you may know who speak other languages
- 8 **SHARE** the names for baby animals (chicks, tadpoles, kittens)
- 9 **SING** “Old McDonald had a Farm” using the animals in the books
- 10 **ASK** your child, “What would you learn to do?” and try something new together



FIVE WAYS TO DISCOVER ANY BOOK WITH A CHILD

Talk about what the book makes you both think or feel.

2

Sing a song that is related to a character or something in the book.

3

Act out parts of the story.

4

Draw a picture of something that happened in the book.

5

Retell the story using the illustrations.
